Softball to be included in first-ever USA Masters Games next summer

OKLAHOMA CITY - The Amateur Softball Association (ASA)/USA Softball, the National Governing Body (NGB) of softball in the U.S., is proud to announce that North Carolina ASA/USA Softball will be participating in the inaugural USA Masters Games next summer in Greensboro, N.C. The USA Masters Games, a National Sports Festival for competitive adult athletes ages 21 and over, will introduce its first-ever event held in 2016 at the Greensboro Coliseum Complex and a number of nearby venues. Expected to draw thousands of competitive adult athletes, the Games will take place over a 10-day period from Friday, July 22 to Sunday, July 31, 2016.

Featuring 20 or more sports competing in the 2016 USA Masters Games, softball will be one of the major sports in this competition. Each sport will be conducted at a National Championship level and will be staged in conjunction with the applicable NGB for each sport. In addition to being an ASA/USA sanctioned event, all officials for softball will be ASA/USA certified umpires.

"On behalf of ASA/USA Softball and NC ASA/USA Softball, we are very happy to be a part of this exciting new sports event," said NC ASA/USA Commissioner Tony Laws. "Masters and Senior softball is an important part of the ASA/USA program as we strive to keep our older adults active and healthy. We look forward to helping make softball a high participation event of the USA Masters Games and to providing a lot of enjoyment for the participants and spectators."

As a new event, the organizers of the USA Masters Games have decades of multi-sport event organizational experience, and the Greensboro Coliseum Complex has its own long history of hosting some of America's largest events. The USA Maters Games will feature an Opening and Closing Ceremonies as well as a Games Village, which will serve as a central hub. The 2016 USA Masters Games will be the first of what are planned to be biennial events, held in the even-numbered years while moving around the country. To enter the 2016 USA Masters Games, registration is expected to open sometime in September. Athletes are eligible to register in as many as three sports without additional games fees.
